After Care Support

Practical assistance to help you maintain your independence and achieve your goals.

Leaving care and moving into independence can be challenging. The After Care Service provides practical financial support to help you access the resources and opportunities you need to maintain stable housing and build your future.

What can brokerage help with?

Everyone's situation is different. If you are experiencing housing instability, brokerage support may be available to help with the practical things you need to stay on track, such as:

- Education
- Employment and training
- Identification and employment related licenses
- Health and wellbeing
- Purchase of household items/resources
- Driving lessons
- Contributions towards a bond or rental agreement
- Contribution to stabilise an existing tenancy

Is this service right for you?

You may be able to access brokerage funding if you:

- Are aged 17 – 21 years
- Are leaving, or have recently left, the care of Child Safety
- Are experiencing homelessness or are at risk of homelessness
- Are working with a support worker or case manager

Not sure if you're eligible? Contact our team to discuss your situation.



How to access support

Speak with your support worker or case manager about your needs. They can complete the application process and submit a request for brokerage funding.

Applications require:

1. Completed application form
2. Goal plan
3. Signed consent form
4. Relevant quotes for requested goods or services
